
Adding HTML Tags

You may have to add an HTML H2 or H4 tag in the exam.


The H in H2 stands for Heading. You can add tags from H1 down to H6.

Method to add an H4 tag:

- 1. Create a textbox using the standard textbox tool (the T tool)
- 2. Add the writing required
- 3. Highlight the text
- 4. At the top of the window find the **Body drop down** next to the name of the font




5. Go all the way to the bottom and choose **More**



- 6. Expand the Headings section
- 7. Choose **Heading 4** > click **OK**

You can adapt this method for other headings



Adding a set colour:

You may need to make the text a specific colour – usually one set by a hex code such as #990000

To do this you need to add the colour to the site palette. There is a separate guide for doing this, but the short version is:

- 1. Click Tools > Colour scheme designer
- 2. Click the **Site Palette** tab at the top right
- 3. Click the + at the bottom
- 4. Add the **hex code** in the box on the right the one at the bottom

The colour will then be in the Swatches at the top right. Simply highlight the text and choose the colour.
