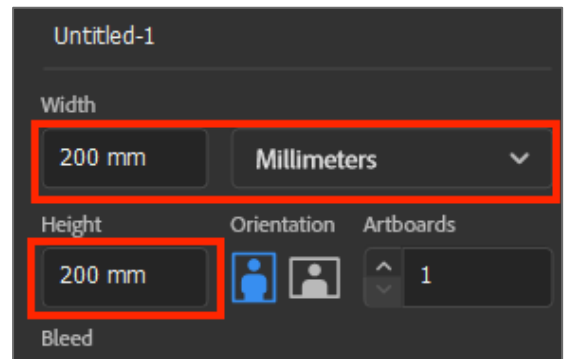


Making the Circle frame

1. Open **Adobe Illustrator**. Click **File > New**
2. On the **right**, create a **200mm** by **200mm** artboard
3. Click **Create**
4. Find the **Rectangle tool** on the left toolbar
5. **Click and hold** on the tool and select **Ellipse**

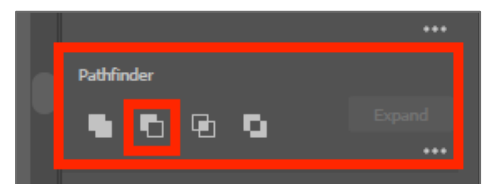


6. Hold **SHIFT** down on the keyboard and draw a circle to just about fill the artboard
7. **IMPORTANT:** on the **right**, find the **Align** section. Click **both** the centre options – vertical and horizontal (use the screenshot)
This will make sure the circle is right in the centre of the artboard

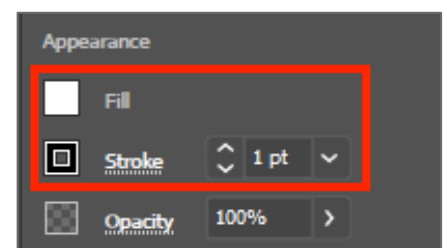


8. Then **draw a second circle** inside the first one to create a frame. Don't make the circle too much smaller – you don't need a very wide frame
9. **IMPORTANT:** centre that circle in the same way (**step 7**)
10. On the **left toolbar**, choose the **Selection Tool** – the **black arrow** at the **top**
11. Select the **outside circle** by clicking on it
12. Hold **SHIFT** down and click on the inside circle as well. This selects both circles at once

13. On the **right**, find the **Pathfinder** section
14. Click the **second shape** – the **Minus Front** one
This combines the two shapes together



15. On the **right**, find the **Appearance** section.
Change the **Fill colour** to something bright (like red). Change the **Stroke weight** to something like **6pt**. You can change the **stroke colour** as well
The stroke is the line around the edge of the shape



16. **Save** your work
