

This way of hiding information is called an **acrostic**

Acrostics

An **acrostic** uses the first letter of each word or paragraph to hide a message.

Acrostic - from the Greek words akros "at the end" + stikhos "row or line"

These are called **mnemonics**

Mnemonics

A **mnemonic** is a way of remembering something - often a sequence of things that need to be learned in order.

The first letter of each word in the mnemonic phrase is the same as the first letter in the thing that needs to be remembered.

Mnemonic - from the Greek word **mnēmonikos**, meaning "of memory"

Mrs Gren **CPOA** EU UK **JPEG** PC

These are **acronyms**

Acronyms

An **acronym** is a word made from the first letters of the words that make up a name or phrase (like NCFC)

Acronym - from the Greek **acr-**, meaning "height, summit, or tip" and **-onym**, meaning "name"

Steganography

Sometimes messages can be hidden so that everyone can see them.

This lesson is all about ways of hiding information in **plain site**. Hiding information but not hiding it.

This is called **steganography**.




Steganography has the advantage that messages don't attract attention.

They don't look like secret codes. So no one tries to break them.

Steganography from the Greek **steganós**, meaning "covered or concealed", and **graphia** meaning "writing"





