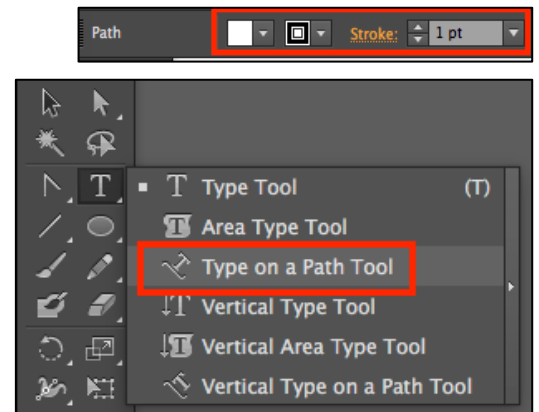


# Text on a circle

You can get text on a perfect circle.

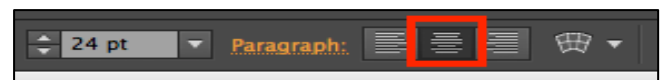
1. Draw a circle – no fill, simple stroke
2. **Click and hold** the **Text tool** on the **left toolbar**
3. Choose the **Type on a Path Tool**



4. **Hover** over the circle you drew until the word **path** appears (in green). **Click once**

5. Start to type

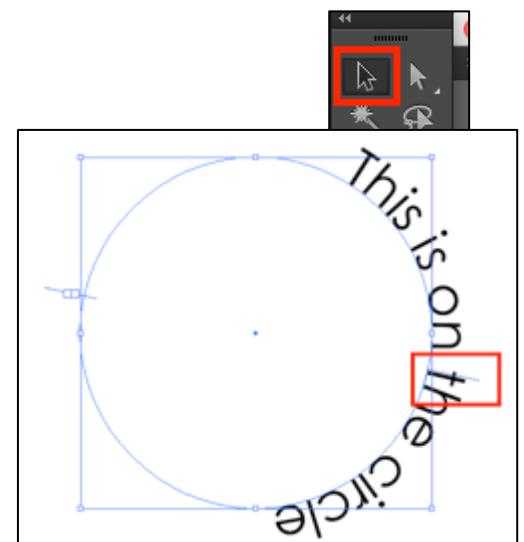
It will help if you **centre** the text (top right)



6. Highlight and adjust the size and font of the text as required

## To move the text

7. Choose the **Selection Tool** on the left toolbar
8. Find the **single purple line** on the text circle  
If you centred the text then this will be in the middle of your text
9. **Drag** this until the text is where you want it (careful – it can do odd stuff)



## Text at the bottom

The easiest way to get two sets of text is to copy the first circle and paste it and then change the text. Make sure the circles are aligned perfectly.

10. If you want to use text at the bottom, you may need to use **Text > Type on a Path > Type on a Path Options**. Change the **Align to Path** dropdown to **Ascender**.
