Flowol - Subroutines

Subroutines are used to:

- simplify your code to make it easier to read (or for someone else to read)
- avoid having to write the same block of code a number of times
- break a bigger problem into smaller steps

Subroutines are an important idea in computer programming

Flowol - Subroutines

Subroutines are smaller programs which run inside larger programs

- 1. Drag out a new **START** block
- 2. Make the block a **SUB** (not a START!)
- 3. Give the SUB a sensible name
- 4. Code the SUB
- 5. End with a **STOP** block
