So, if you have five questions, you'll need six sets of blocks (because you can also score 0)

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## A more complex method using nested IF:



This says: if it's 5, do that; otherwise if it's greater than 2 (so 3 or 4 ), do this; otherwise if it's greater than 0 (1 or 2) do that; otherwise do the last thing It works by putting IF-ELSE inside other IF-ELSE - which is nesting your IFs...
