## Text on a circle

You can get text on a perfect circle.

1. Use the Ellipse Tool (under the Rectangle Tool) to draw a circle - it doesn't matter about the fill or stroke colours
2. Click and hold the Type Tool on the left toolbar
3. Choose the Type on a Path Tool
4. The circle will change to get rid of any colours

5. Hover over the circle you drew until the word path appears (in green). Click once
6. Start to type

It might help if you centre the text - on the right sidebar find the Paragraph section
7. Change the size and font as required on the right sidebar

## To move the text

8. Choose the Selection Tool on the left toolbar (the top arrow)
9. Find the single purple line on the text circle If you centred the text then this will be in the middle of your text
10. Drag this until the text is where you want it (careful - it can do odd stuff)

## Text at the bottom

The easiest way to get two sets of text is to copy the first circle and paste it and then change the text. Make sure the circles are aligned perfectly
